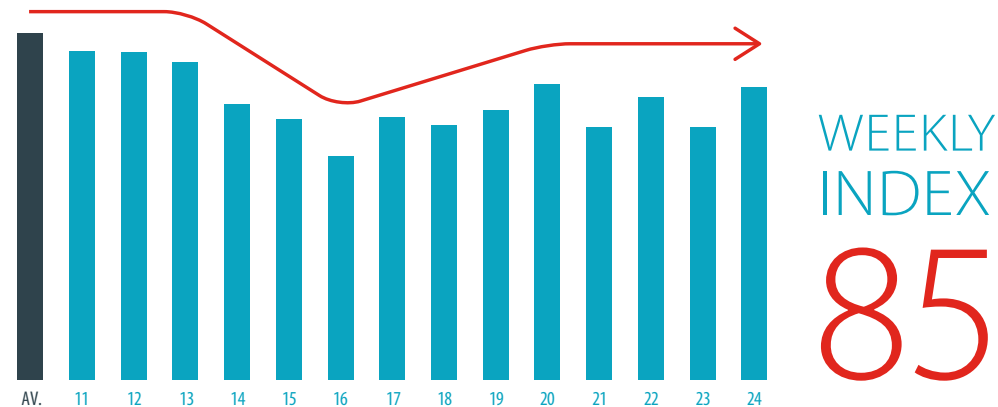
The effect of COVID-19 on logistic activities



19 June 2020 | On 10 April, we published our first Logistics Barometer. Since then, we have issued ten versions of this useful source of information. For now, this eleventh edition will be the last one we publish.

We are ending this series of Logistics Barometer with a weekly index of 85 and 32% of the European countries with an index above 100. Of the 12 countries selected for this overview, the United Kingdom and Italy have the highest index (108), while the Netherlands ends with an index of 99. Lowest is Poland, which currently has an index of 71. All in all, the situation seems to be stabilizing in Europe now that corona-related measures are ending and the number of national holidays has also decreased.
